AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A RETAINED REVENUE ACCOUNT FOR THE END OF LIFE COMMISSION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 480 of chapter 159 of the Acts of 2000 as most recently  
2 amended by section 2 item 1599-0041 of chapter 184 of the Acts of  
3 2002 is hereby further amended by placing at the end thereof the  
4 following:—

5 The commission to study the provision of end of life care services  
6 shall have a retained revenue account established upon the books of  
7 the Treasurer of the Commonwealth within the Massachusetts Man-  
8 agement Accounting and Reporting System, whereupon all receipts,  
9 fees, and revenues as collected by the commission to study the pro-  
10 vision of end of life care services during the delivery of such duties  
11 shall be deposited within said account shall be retained and  
12 expended to meet the operational costs associated with the commis-  
13 sion; furthermore, that all expenses associated with the operation of  
14 the commission shall be paid from said retained revenue account and  
15 shall be in conformance with existing expenditure classification reg-  
16 ulations; in addition, said account shall be managed in accordance  
17 with generally accepted accounting principles and shall comply with  
18 all relevant provisions as stipulated under MGL Chapter 29.
