AN ACT RELATIVE TO TAX EXEMPTION OF SALES OF CERTAIN MOLDS AND MOLD COMPONENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Subsection (r) of section 6 of Chapter 64H of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 1998 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 inserting in line 232 after the words “any substitute therefor” the
4 following:
5 “and sales of molds or mold components”
6 Subsection (s) of section 6 of Chapter 64H of the General Laws, as
7 appearing in the 1998 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
8 inserting in line 259 after “replacement parts thereof” the following:
9 “and sales of molds or mold components and machinery producing
10 molds or mold components for use directly and exclusively in actual
11 manufacture whether or not the molds or mold components are sold
12 to a customer”.
