AN ACT RELATIVE TO REAL ESTATE TAX EXEMPTIONS FOR VETERANS AND FRATERNAL ORGANIZATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause Fifth of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in the 2000 Official Edition, is hereby amended
3 by striking out the words "two hundred thousand dollars", in lines
4 125 and 126, and inserting in place thereof the following figure:—
5 "\$700,000".

1 SECTION 2. Said clause Fifth of said section 5 of said chapter 59,
2 as so appearing, is hereby further amended by striking out the words
3 "four hundred thousand dollars", in lines 133 and 134, and inserting
4 in place thereof the following figure:— "\$950,000".

1 SECTION 3. Said section 5 of said chapter 59 of the General Laws,
2 as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out clause Fifth B.

1 SECTION 4. Clause Seventh of said section 5 of said chapter 59
2 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by
3 striking out the word "Personal", in line 164, and inserting in place
4 thereof the following words:— "Real and personal".
