By Mr. O'Leary, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 2197) of Robert A. O'Leary and Eric Turkington (by vote of the town) for legislation relative to the lease of a property in Oak Bluffs. Local Affairs and Regional Government. [Local approval received.]

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LEASE OF A PROPERTY IN OAK BLUFFS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the
2 contrary, the Selectmen of the Town of Oak Bluffs are hereby autho-
3 rized to enter into a lease upon such terms and conditions as they
4 shall determine not to exceed 99 years for the land and building
5 located at 2 Oak Bluffs Avenue in the Town of Oak Bluffs.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
