## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Four.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO ANTIQUE AUTO REGISTRATION FEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 33 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out clause (13) and inserting in place thereof  
3 the following section:—

4 (13) For the registration of every antique motor car the fee shall  
5 be \$36; provided that said fee shall be collected every two years.  
6 The registrar shall collect such similar fee, in addition to incurred  
7 administrative costs for the issuance in connection therewith, at  
8 the request of the applicant, of a distinctive initial plate, or of a  
9 particular number plate other than a distinctive initial plate; pro-  
10 vided, however, that the registrar shall collect a similar fee for the  
11 issuance of a number plate bearing the station call letters of an  
12 amateur radio operator. Said registrar shall make available to reg-  
13 istered owners of antique motor cars any unissued or returned dis-  
14 tinctive initialed or number registration plates.
