By Mr. Tarr, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 565) of Bruce E. Tarr, James R. Miceli and Charles A. Murphy (by vote of the town) for legislation for a civil service exemption for Joseph A. Vieira III in the town of Wilmington. Public Service.

AN ACT CIVIL SERVICE EXEMPTION FOR JOSEPH A. VIEIRA III IN THE TOWN OF WILMINGTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 “Notwithstanding any general law or specific law or rules or reg-
2 ulations to the contrary regulating the maximum age of applicants
3 for appointments as a firefighter, the town of Wilmington is hereby
4 authorized to allow Joseph A. Vieira III to take the civil service Fire
5 Fighters examination. Provided successful completion of said exam-
6 ination compliance with all other requirements, he shall be eligible
7 for certification and appointment of the appointing authority.”
