AN ACT RELATIVE TO FARM-WINERIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
- 2 the contrary, a person holding a farmer-winery license under the pro-
- 3 visions of sections nineteen B of chapter one hundred and thirty-
- 4 eight of the General Laws may receive orders for the sale and
- 5 delivery of wine within and outside of the commonwealth and may
- 6 ship wines to the purchaser.
