AN ACT RELATIVE TO SCHOOL FUNDING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any rule of law or regulation to the contrary
2 requiring the state to pay 100 per cent of the cost of public school
3 education with federal grants grades K to 12 and grades to 12 voca-
4 tional and trade schools to allow poor towns and cities equal cost in
5 education school committees continue under home rule to control
6 schools.
