AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN DISTRICT COURTS IN ESSEX COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by Section 51 of chapter 45 of the acts of
3 2003, is hereby further amended by striking out, under the caption
4 “Essex”, the second paragraph.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 1 of said chapter 218, as so
2 amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the third para-
3 graph and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:—
4 The district court of eastern Essex, held at Gloucester, Essex,
5 Gloucester, Hamilton, Rockport and Wenham.

1 SECTION 3. Said section 1 of said chapter 218, as so amended,
2 is hereby further amended by striking out, under the caption
3 “Essex” the sixth paragraph and inserting in place thereof the
4 following paragraph:—
5 The district court of Newburyport held at Newburyport; Ames-
6 bury, Ipswich, Merrimac, Newbury, Newburyport, Rowley, Salis-
7 bury, Topsfield and West Newbury.
