AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TERM OF SERVICE FOR CERTAIN MEMBERS OF LOCAL RETIREMENT BOARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision (4) of section 20 of
2 chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002 Official
3 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 187 to 189,
4 the words "a second member appointed by the board of selectmen
5 in a town, the mayor in a city, the city manager in a city having a
6 Plan D or Plan E form of government" and inserting in place
7 thereof the following words:— a second member appointed by the
8 board of selectmen in a town, the mayor in a city, the city man-
9 ager in a city having a Plan D or Plan E form of government for a
10 term of 2 years.

1 SECTION 2. Any incumbent second board member who has
2 been in a position on the board in any city or town for over 2
3 years shall cease to be a member of the board upon enactment of
4 this act but may be considered for reappointment to any of the
5 second, third, fourth, or fifth membership position.

6 No member appointed or having served more than 3 terms shall
7 be reappointed to any of the second, third, fourth or fifth member-
8 ship positions.

9 No member of any city or town board of retirement shall also
10 be a member of any other city or town retirement board simulta-
11 neously.
