AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MINIMUM PENSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2 out section 90C½, as added by section 109 of chapter 194 of the
3 acts of 1998, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section:—
5 Section 90C½. A state employee or member of the state
6 teachers' retirement system who has been retired under the provi-
7 sions of this chapter or similar provision of earlier law on a super-
8 annuation, accidental disability or ordinary disability retirement
9 allowance and, who has completed at least 25 years of creditable
10 service shall have his retirement allowance increased to an
11 amount not to exceed \$18,620; provided, however, that such
12 allowance shall be subject to the provisions of paragraph (e) of
13 section 102. Any such adjustments shall be paid from the Pension
14 Reserve Investment Trust Fund.
