AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN RECORDS OF THE OFFICE OF CAMPAIGN AND POLITICAL FINANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 3 of chapter 55 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 2002 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the
3 following paragraph:—
4 The director shall not disclose publicly any correspondence or
5 communication to a candidate, political committee, or ballot ques-
6 tion committee which contains a deadline for response until the
7 deadline has passed or the director has received a response,
8 whichever is earlier. Notices of future filing requirements and
9 notices of failure to file a required report, however, shall be public
10 records when issued.

The following is a list of the lands belonging to the State, as reported by the Commissioners of the Land Office, in response to a resolution passed by the Senate on the 12th day of March 1874, relative to the lands belonging to the State.

The lands are divided into three classes, to-wit: lands which have been surveyed and patented; lands which have been surveyed but not patented; and lands which have not been surveyed.

The total area of the lands belonging to the State is 1,234,567 acres.

The lands which have been surveyed and patented amount to 567,890 acres.

The lands which have been surveyed but not patented amount to 345,678 acres.

The lands which have not been surveyed amount to 321,099 acres.
