AN ACT RELATIVE TO LITTERING FROM A MOTOR VEHICLE ON PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002 Offi-
2 cial Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 22H the
3 following new section:—
4 Section 22I. Any operator of a motor vehicle who litters, or
5 who knowingly permits, as the operator, occupants of his vehicle
6 to litter, public or private property through the disposal of trash or
7 garbage from the vehicle shall be subject to a civil fine not greater
8 than \$100. A penalty under this paragraph shall not be a sur-
9 chargeable offense under section 113B of chapter 175.
