AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE RIGHTS OF AN ADOPTED CHILD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 27 of the acts of 1969, as amended by section 3 of
2 chapter 769 of the acts of 1975, is hereby further amended by
3 striking out section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section:—

5 Section 2. Section 8 of chapter 210 of the General Laws shall
6 be applicable to grants, trust settlements, entails, devises or
7 bequests executed before or after the effective date of this act.
