AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN PARCELS OF LAND IN
THE CITY OF TAUNTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Bristol County shall, for consideration of \$1, convey 2 parcels
2 of land with improvements thereon, currently owned and con-
3 trolled by the county, to the commonwealth acting by and through
4 its division of capital asset management and maintenance. These
5 parcels of land are designated as the Bristol County Superior
6 Court, located at 9 Court street in the city of Taunton, and the
7 Bristol County District Court, Taunton Division, located at 15
8 Court street in the city of Taunton. These conveyances shall occur
9 within 90 days after written request to the county by the commis-
10 sioner of the division.
