AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LICENSING OF INSURANCE ADVISORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 177B of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 7 of chapter 1000 of the acts of 1977, is
3 hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph: —

4 The commissioner shall waive the requirements of a written
5 examination to act as an insurance advisor to any applicant who
6 has been awarded the designation of Certified Insurance Counselor.
7 Upon the filing of an application and the payment of the fee
8 prescribed by section fourteen, an applicant, who has the designation
9 of Certified Insurance Counselor, shall be issued a license to
10 act as an insurance advisor for property and casualty insurance.
