AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CONTRACT POWER OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of chapter 28 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 1 of chapter 562 of the acts of 1961, is hereby
3 amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in place
4 thereof the following sentence: — The concurrence of the commis-
5 sioner and of not less than two associate commissioners shall be
6 required for the execution of contracts and of such other official
7 actions of the commission as may be required by law; provided,
8 however, that by a vote of three associate commissioners without
9 the concurrence of the commissioner contracts may be executed by
10 the commissioner and all other official actions as may be required
11 by law may be performed.
