### **AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PROPERTY TAX ABATEMENT FOR SUBTERRANEAN DWELLINGS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or specific law to the contrary,
- 2 subterranean resident dwellings shall be entitled to a property tax
- 3 abatement of five hundred dollars for a period of ten years.
