AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT WHICH MAY BE WITHHELD BY
STAMPERS UNDER THE CIGARETTE EXCISE TAX LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The third paragraph of section 30 of chapter 64C of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by section 3 of chapter 361 of the
3 acts of 1969, is hereby further amended by striking the words "one
4 dollar and sixty cents", in line 5, and inserting in place thereof the
5 words: — two dollars.
