AN ACT ENCOURAGING THE USE OF ENERGY SAVING MATERIALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 6 of Chapter 64H of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by the Acts of 1979, is hereby further amended by adding
- 3 the following paragraph: —
- 4 (gg) Sales of weather stripping, storm windows and doors, insu-
- 5 lation and caulking compounds for residential use.
