AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PRINTING AND DISTRIBUTION OF STATE PUBLICATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 5 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 1 the following section: —

3 *Section 1A.* All revenue which is generated from the sale of
4 publications shall be deposited with, and held in trust by the State
5 Treasurer. Funds held in trust will be expended at the discretion of
6 the State Secretary for the purpose of publishing vital state publi-
7 cations and distributing them at a reasonable cost. It is also pro-
8 vided that the Treasurer shall from time to time transfer all funds in
9 excess of twenty-five thousand dollars from the trust fund to the
10 General Fund.
