AN ACT RELATIVE TO ELECTIONS AFFECTING THE SO-CALLED TWO AND ONE-HALF TAX LIMITATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 21 C of chapter 59 of the General Laws, is
2 hereby amended, in subsections (1) and (4) by striking out, in each
3 instance, the words "general court" and inserting in place thereof,
4 in each instance, the words: —

5 Aldermen, in the case of cities and selectmen, in the case of
6 towns.

1 SECTION 2. Said subsections (1) and (4) of section 21C of
2 chapter 59 of the General Laws are hereby further amended by
3 inserting after the word "held," in each instance, the words: —

4 Or on any other day.
