AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ELIMINATION OF COUNTY GOVERNMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 34 and 35 of the General Laws are hereby repealed as
2 are all other general or special laws assigning or defining powers,
3 responsibilities and functions of county governments except for
4 judicial functions.
