## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-One.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ELIMINATION OF BINDING INTEREST ARBITRATION FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSIT AUTHORITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of general or spe-  
2 cial laws to the contrary, Binding Interest Arbitration for em-  
3 ployees of the Massachusetts Bay Transit Authority — (MBTA) be  
4 and hereby is eliminated.

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 1981 and  
2 further it shall be retroactive to said date in the event its passage  
3 and enactment takes place after the effective date specified herein.
