AN ACT TO ALLOW CERTAIN OTHER PERSONS TO TRANSPORT ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHOUT A PERMIT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The first paragraph of Section 22 of Chapter 138 of the General  
2 Laws is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the follow-  
3 ing: — , and further provided, that any person may transport  
4 alcoholic beverages in interstate commerce without a permit on the  
5 condition that none of the said beverages are picked up and/or  
6 delivered within the Commonwealth.
