## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-One.

AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN CHANGES IN THE OPERATION OF THE STATE LOTTERY.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat  
2 its purpose, which in part is to provide at once additional revenue  
3 for the commonwealth, therefore it is hereby declared to be an  
4 emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the  
5 public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 24 of Chapter 10 of the General Laws, as inserted by  
2 Chapter 813 of the Acts of 1971 and amended by Chapter 156 of the  
3 Acts of 1974, is hereby further amended by inserting the following  
4 paragraph at the end of said Section 24:—

5 The commission is hereby authorized to sell such surplus equip-  
6 ment and material as is no longer required in the conduct of such  
7 State Lottery.

8 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, the  
9 proceeds of the sale of any equipment shall be credited in accord-  
10 ance with the provisions of Section 35(C) of Chapter 10 of the  
11 General Laws.
