By Mr. Decas of Wareham, petition of Charles N. Decas (by vote of the town) for legislation to validate the action taken by the town of Carver to transfer a certain sum of money previously raised by borrowing. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT VALIDATING THE ACTION TAKEN BY THE TOWN OF CARVER TO TRANSFER A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY PREVIOUSLY RAISED BY BORROWING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The action taken by the Town of Carver on July
2 10, 1980 under Article 2 of the warrant for its 1980 Special Town
3 Meeting by which said town voted unanimously to transfer the sum
4 of fifty thousand dollars from its school building construction
5 account to a special account for the purpose of repairing, remodel-
6 ing and otherwise improving its school buildings is hereby validat-
7 ed, confirmed and made effective notwithstanding any provision of
8 Section 20 of Chapter 44 of the General Laws to the contrary.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
