AN ACT TO BRING THE WORKING OF THE WETLANDS PROTECTION ACT INTO AGREEMENT WITH THAT OF THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 40 of Chapter 131 of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 Chapter 818 of the Acts of 1974, is hereby amended by striking out
- 3 in the ninth and tenth lines of the thirteenth paragraph thereof the
- 4 words "or any ten residents of the city or town in which such land is
- 5 located" and substituting therefor the words "or any ten persons".
