The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-One.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONS ATTENDING CERTAIN FACILITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section twenty-seven of chapter nineteen of the
2 General Laws is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. Said chapter 19 is hereby further amended by
2 striking out section 28, as most recently amended by section 3 of
3 chapter 888 of the acts of 1970, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following section:—

5 *Section 28.* Whenever a mentally retarded person qualifies for
6 attendance at an educational, habitational or day care program
7 or facility of the department of mental health, and said person is
8 not eligible for services under the provisions of chapter seventy-one
9 B, the department shall provide for the transportation of said
10 persons to and from such facility on such days as it is in session.

1 SECTION 3. Section thirteen of chapter seventy-one B of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by section seventy I of
3 chapter seventy-eight, is hereby repealed.
