AN ACT PROVIDING TENURE FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF HOUSING AUTHORITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 26S of chapter 121 of the General Laws is hereby amend-
2 ed by striking out the second paragraph, as amended by chapter
3 784 of the acts of 1962, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 paragraph:—

5 Chapter thirty-one and the rules made thereunder shall not
6 apply to any officer, agent or employee of a housing authority or of
7 the housing board or to any person employed on or in connection
8 with any project of a housing authority; provided, however, that no
9 employee of the state housing board or of any housing authority,
10 except an employee occupying the position of executive secretary,
11 who has held his office or position, including any promotion or
12 reallocation therefrom within the board or authority, for a total
13 period of three years of uninterrupted service shall be involuntarily
14 separated therefrom except subject to and in accordance with the
15 provisions of sections forty-three and forty-five of said chapter
16 thirty-one to the same extent as if said office or position were
17 classified under said chapter.
