The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-One.

AN ACT REQUIRING THE COMMONWEALTH TO REIMBURSE CITIES FOR THE COST INCURRED FOR STATE ELECTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the com-
2 monwealth shall reimburse the cities for the cost of biennial state
3 elections. Such costs shall be tabulated by the boards of registrars
4 of voters or the election commissioners, and upon certification by
5 the auditors of each respective city and presentation to the state
6 treasurer, such costs incurred in holding the biennial elections shall
7 be reimbursed to the cities of the commonwealth.
