## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO REMOVAL OF BARGAINING OF IMPEDIMENTS OF CHAPTER 32B SECTION 7A.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

Section 7A of chapter 32B of the General Laws as most recently amended by chapter 789 of the acts of 1973 is hereby further amended by striking out the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

A governmental unit which has accepted the provisions of section ten and which accepts the provisions of this section may, as a part of the total monthly cost of contracts of insurance authorized by sections three and eleven O, with contributions as required by section seven, make payment of a subsidiary or additional rate which may be lower or higher than a premium determined by the governmental unit to be paid by the insured, the combination of which shall result in the governmental unit making payment of more, but not less, than fifty per cent of the total monthly cost for such insurance.
