Chap. 251. AN ACT VALIDATING THE AUTHORIZATION OF CERTAIN BONDS BY THE TOWN OF MANCHESTER.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. All acts and proceedings taken by the town of Manchester at the adjourned session of its annual town meeting held May fourteenth, nineteen hundred and eighty-four, appropriating funds and authorizing the borrowing of two hundred thousand dollars for an ocean outfall for the town's wastewater treatment facility, are hereby validated, ratified and confirmed as if said appropriating and authorizing of borrowing had been voted by said town meeting in accordance with law.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 252. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMPENSATION OF SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEMBERS IN THE CITY OF NORTHAMPTON.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, members of the school committee in the city of Northampton may be compensated by a majority vote of the city council.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 253. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE NOMINATING OF ELECTIVE MUNICIPAL OFFICERS IN THE CITY OF NORTHAMPTON.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. In the city of Northampton, candidates for elective municipal offices shall be nominated as follows:-

(1) Preliminary Elections; Nominations. Not less than twenty-eight days nor more than forty-two days preceding every regular city election and every special election at which any municipal office is to be filled, there shall be held, except as otherwise provided in section seven, a preliminary election for
