AN ACT PROVIDING FOR UNIFORM APPROVAL OF AIRPORT REGULATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 51J of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 chapter 613 of the acts of 1946, is hereby amended by striking out
3 the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following two
4 sentences: —

5 An airport commission or instrumentality of the commonwealth
6 operating an airport shall adopt rules and regulations for the use of
7 airports under the authority of such airport commission of instru-
8 mentality or for the safety of the public upon or beyond the limits
9 of airports under its control. The rules and regulations adopted by
10 an airport commission pursuant to this section shall have full force
11 and effect whether the airport facilities controlled by such airport
12 commission are within or without the territorial limits of the city or
13 town.
