AN ACT TO LIMIT TO SCHOOL AGE CHILDREN THE SPECIAL EDUCATION COSTS FOR WHICH SCHOOL COMMITTEES MUST PAY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 5 of chapter 71B of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by striking out the period at the end of the first paragraph thereof  
3 and inserting in its place the following: — ; provided that a school  
4 committee need not provide special education to any child who has  
5 not attained the age of five years or to any person who has complet-  
6 ed the requirements for the twelfth grade.
