RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE USE OF INERTIAL STORAGE TRANSMISSIONS IN CERTAIN VEHICLES.

Resolved, That a special commission to consist of two members of the senate, three members of the house of representatives and three persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established to make an investigation and study relative to the use of inertial storage transmissions, so called, in buses, mail trucks, and other similar vehicles. In the course of said investigation and study said commission shall consider the fuel savings involved in the use of such transmission systems. The commission shall report to the general court the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of such legislation as may be necessary to carry such recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or 12 before the last Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred and 13 eighty-two.
