AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MARKING OF CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 An act prohibiting the rounding off of marks on all civil service
- 2 examinations pertaining to the fire service and furthermore the
- 3 marking of all civil service examinations pertaining to the fire
- 4 service will be carried out to the one hundredth of a percent.
