## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-One.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE ESTIMATED INCOME TAX PROVISIONS OF THE COMMONWEALTH RELATING TO FARMERS BE EXTENDED TO IN-CLUDE FISHERMEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Chapter 62B of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
- out section 15, inserted by section 1 of chapter 17 of the acts of
- 1959, and inserting in place thereof the following section: -
- Section 15. In the case of a taxpayer whose estimated gross
- 5 income from farming or fishing for the taxable year is at least two
- 6 thirds of his total gross income from all sources for the taxable
- year, in lieu of the time prescribed in section thirteen, the declara-
- 8 tion for the taxable year may be made at any time on or before
- 9 January fifteenth of the succeeding year. If such taxpayer makes a
- 10 declaration of estimated tax after September fifteenth of the taxa-
- 11 ble year and on or before January fifteenth of the succeeding year,
- 12 the estimated tax shall be paid in full at the time of the filing of the
- 13 declaration
