### AN ACT TO ENCOURAGE VOTER REGISTRATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 51 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 42D, the following section:—
- 3 *Section 42E.* The registrars or election commissioners shall
- 4 cause applications to register to vote to be distributed to all gradu-
- 5 ates of Massachusetts high schools at the time of their graduation.
