AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING PAYMENT OF COSTS BY THE LOTTERY COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 25 of chapter 10 of the General Laws, added by section 2
2 of chapter 813 of the acts of 1971, is hereby amended by striking
3 out subsection (b) and inserting in place thereof the following
4 subsection:—

5 (b) the payment of costs incurred in the operation and adminis-
6 tration of the lottery, including the expenses of the commission and
7 the costs resulting from any contract or contracts entered into for
8 promotional, advertising or operational services, or for the pur-
9 chase or lease of lottery equipment and materials which in no case
10 shall exceed fifteen per cent of the total revenues accruing from the
11 sale of lottery tickets, subject to appropriation; provided, however,
12 that the costs resulting from a contract or contracts entered into for
13 promotional or advertising services shall in no case exceed one and
14 one-half per cent of the total revenues, herein.
