AN ACT RELATIVE TO EXAMINATIONS FOR FIREFIGHTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
- 2 examinations for firefighters in the commonwealth shall be held
- 3 every two years. When a list is established there shall not be a
- 4 merger of lists for firefighters.
