RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMITTEE RELATIVE TO ACQUIRING LAND, MAKING A PROFIT FROM SAID LAND AND NOT APPLYING THE PROFIT TO THE RATE BASE.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission to consist of two members
2 of the Senate, three members of the house of representatives and
3 one person to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established
4 to make an investigation and study relative to a utility company
5 acquiring land, making a profit from said land and not applying
6 the profit to the rate base.
