RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF COMMUNITIES AND DEVELOPMENT RELATIVE TO THE FEDERAL CENSUS DEMOGRAPHIC DATA.

1 *Resolved*, That the executive office of communities and develop-
2 ment is hereby authorized and directed to make an investigation
3 and study of the demographic data supplied by the federal bureau
4 of census for the purpose of accumulating further such data and
5 refining all such data so as to relate it to identifiable neighbor-
6 hoods. Said executive office shall report to the general court the
7 results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if
8 any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recom-
9 mendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk of the
10 house of representatives on or before the last Wednesday of Janu-
11 ary, nineteen hundred and eighty-two.

It is the duty of the House to consider the report of the committee on the subject of the proposed amendment to the Constitution of the United States, and to report thereon to the Senate.

The Constitution of the United States

Article I, Section 1, Clause 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Representatives and Electors in Congress shall be chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors in that State.
