**Chap. 275. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CERTIFICATION AND APPOINTMENT OF HOWARD J. HUNTER AS A POLICE OFFICER NOTWITHSTANDING CERTAIN PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS.**

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately authorize the certification and appointment of Howard J. Hunter as a police officer, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The personnel administrator of the division of personnel administration shall examine and certify Howard J. Hunter for appointment as a police officer according to the grade he received in the examination for police officer held on October first, nineteen hundred and eighty-three notwithstanding a post trauma limitation of movement of the right wrist; provided, however, that he fulfills all other requirements for certification and appointment, including a retesting under the department of personnel administration's public safety medical standards.

**Chap. 276. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MUTUAL SAVINGS CENTRAL FUND AND PROVIDING FOR A CONVERSION OF A FEDERAL SAVINGS BANK TO A STATE-CHARTERED SAVINGS BANK.**

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 167E of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 3A, as appearing in section 9 of chapter 155 of the acts of 1982, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 3A. Any note or mortgage secured by a first lien on a dwelling house of four or fewer separate households occupied or to be occupied in whole or in part by the mortgagor may provide for monthly payments of interest only for up to the first ten
