## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

AN ACT RELATIVE TO ASSAULT AND BATTERY UPON POLICE OFFICERS OR  
FIRE FIGHTERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 13D of chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by deleting the words "imprisonment for not less than ten  
3 days nor more than two and one-half years in a house of correction  
4 or by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars nor more than five  
5 hundred dollars", and substituting the following "imprisonment  
6 for not less than thirty days nor more than four years in a house of  
7 correction or by a fine of not less than five hundred dollars nor  
8 more than one thousand dollars".
