AN ACT REGULATING THE COMPENSATION OF JURORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 262 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2 out section 25, as most recently amended by section 272 of chapter
3 478 of the acts of 1978, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section:—

5 *Section 25.* The compensation of all traverse and grand jurors
6 shall be thirty dollars for each day's service. All jurors shall receive
7 for each day of actual attendance twenty cents a mile for travel out
8 and home. If a grand or traverse juror is required to be in attend-
9 ance for five or more consecutive days he shall receive his fees no
10 later than the end of every fifth day of such attendance.
