AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF ASSISTANT REGISTERS OF PROBATE BY THE REGISTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 23A of chapter 217 of the General Laws as appearing in
2 section 148 of chapter 478 of the Acts of 1978 is hereby amended by
3 striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the
4 following sentence: —
5 In addition to the first assistant registers of probate provided for in
6 section twenty-three, the registers of the respective divisions of the
7 probate and family court department, with the approval of the
8 judges of said divisions, may appoint assistant registers with the
9 same powers and duties.
