AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYMENTS OF CERTAIN FUNDS BY THE TOWN OF WILMINGTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Town of Wilmington is hereby authorized to
2 appropriate and pay to Warren Five Cents Savings Banks of
3 Peabody the sum of ninety-one and 53/100 (\$91.53) dollars, the
4 same being the amount collected by the said Town from Warren
5 Five Cents Savings Bank as taxes in the year 1979 upon certain real
6 property in said Town.

1 SECTION 2. Any action taken by the Town of Wilmington at
2 its Annual Town Meeting held in the current year or at any
3 adjourned session thereof pursuant to the authority contained in
4 this act is hereby validated and confirmed and shall have the same
5 effect as though this act were in full force and effect on the date of
6 the posting of the Warrant for such Meeting.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage;
