AN ACT RELATING TO THE FUNDING OF SALARIES PAYABLE DURING THE MONTHS OF JULY AND AUGUST TO TEACHERS AND OTHER PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES OF THE SCHOOL DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWN OF NORTHBRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or  
2 special law to the contrary, the town of Northbridge is hereby  
3 authorized to exclude from its budget for the fiscal year ending  
4 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and eighty-one, two-thirds of the  
5 estimated amounts to be earned by the teachers or any other  
6 professional employees of the school department for the school  
7 year ending on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and eighty-two  
8 which are actually payable during the months of July and August  
9 of the year nineteen hundred and eighty-two. For the fiscal year  
10 commencing on July first, nineteen hundred and eighty-two, said  
11 town shall budget the full amounts necessary to make payments  
12 during the months of July and August, nineteen hundred and  
13 eighty-three of monies earned by teachers or any other professional  
14 employees for the school year ending on June thirtieth, nineteen  
15 hundred and eighty-three.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
