AN ACT MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR COMMUTER RAIL SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing an item of general
2 appropriation for the purpose of commuter rail service, the sum set
3 forth in section two subject to the provisions of law regulating the
4 disbursement of public funds and the conditions pertaining to
5 appropriations in chapter three hundred and twenty-nine of the
6 acts of nineteen hundred and eighty, for the fiscal year ending June
7 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and eighty-one, the sum so appropriat-
8 ed to be in addition to any amounts available for that purpose.

1 SECTION 2.

For additional contract assistance to the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority for the fiscal year nineteen hundred and eighty-one for the provision of commuter rail service, including the extension of service to the town of Haverhill and Gardner, in accordance with the provisions of section twenty-eight A of chapter one hundred and sixty-one A of the General Laws; provided however, that the proportion of such additional contract assistance in combination with any federal operating assistance to the costs assessed to said cities and towns received for the same period shall not be less than the proportion of combined additional state contract assistance and federal operating assistance to said assessments to the cities and towns effective on March first, nineteen hundred and seventy-eight; and, provided further, that of the amount appropriated herein, three hundred and ninety-nine thousand seven hundred ten dollars may be expended for additional contract assistance for fiscal year nineteen hundred and eighty.
